CAPSULE ENDOSCOPY PREP INSTRUCTIONS

The capsule endoscopy is a capsule you swallow that contains a miniature video camera. The camera takes pictures of your small intestine as it passes through. It transmits the pictures to a data recorder that you will wear on a belt. The test takes approximately eight hours to complete.

IMPORTANT - Please let us know if you have the following:

Implanted pacemaker or other implanted electrical devices
Trouble swallowing
Possible obstruction or stricture in the GI tract
History of GI surgery and/or radiation of the abdomen for cancer

7 DAYS BEFORE YOUR ENDOSCOPY

• Pick up your prescription for Suprep at your pharmacy. Also purchase Simethicone ('Gas Relief', Gas-X') 125 mg tablets. You will need to have 6 tablets.

5 DAYS BEFORE YOUR ENDOSCOPY

Review diet instructions and plan your meals

Stop taking medicines for diarrhea - such as imodium, Lomotil or Pepto Bismol.

Stop taking fiber supplements - such as Metamucil, Citrucel or Perdiem

Stop taking iron pills or multi-vitamins that contain iron

Last chance to cancel/reschedule your procedure appointment without incurring a **CANCELLATION FEE of \$200**

3 DAYS BEFORE YOUR ENDOSCOPY

•STOP eating any raw vegetables or vegetables containing seeds (cooked vegetables are OK). No corn, popcorn, nuts, seeds, and stop any fiber supplements until after the colonoscopy. TIP: Avoiding seeds, nuts, and fibrous foods will yield a more effective bowel cleansing and allows your doctor to perform a more thorough examination.

2 DAYS BEFORE YOUR ENDOSCOPY

•Increase your fluid intake, drink a minimum of 8 glasses of clear liquids.

1 DAY BEFORE YOUR ENDOSCOPY

■ Begin a "Clear Liquid Diet."

Clear liquids include:

IMPORTANT: nothing red or purple!

- Gatorade, Pedialyte, or Powerade
- Clear broth or bouillon
- Coffee or tea (no milk or non-dairy creamer)
- Carbonated and non-carbonated soft drinks (Coke is OK)
- Coconut water (no pulp)
- Kool-Aid or other fruit-flavored drinks
- Jello, popsicles (not containing any pieces of fruit)
- Gummy Bears
- <u>Between 4 and 6 pm</u>: Take three 125-mg Simethicone tablets prior to drinking the SuPrep solution. Pour one 6-ounce bottle of Suprep liquid into the mixing container; add cold water to the 16-ounce line on the container and mix. Drink all of the liquid in the Suprep container.
- TIP: If you experience nausea while drinking the solution, take a 30-45 minute break and continue drinking the solution at a slower pace.
- After drinking the prep solution, drink 32 ounces of water over the next 2 hours.

THE DAY OF YOUR ENDOSCOPY

- Do NOT take Carafate (sucralfate) or any antacids.
- Prepare and drink the second bottle of SuPrep just like you did with the first bottle. Take three 125-mg Simethicone tablets prior to drinking the SuPrep solution. Drink the SuPrep solution 5-6 hours before your arrival time. Drink all of the liquid in the SuPrep container.
- After drinking the SuPrep solution, please drink 32 oz. of water.
- Make sure to take your morning blood pressure or heart medications 2-3 hours before your arrival time.
- You must complete your SuPrep solution and <u>discontinue all clear liquids</u> 2 hours prior to your arrival time.
- Please wear comfortable, loose clothing. Do not use lotions or powders on the abdominal area the day of the exam. You will be fitted with a belt containing the data recorder.
- After swallowing the capsule do NOT eat or drink anything for two hours.

- After two hours have passed you may have a sip of water. After four hours, you may have half a sandwich and salad.
- After swallowing the capsule and until the time it is excreted you must NOT be near a magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) machine or schedule an MRI examination.
- Return to the doctor's office at 4:30pm to have the equipment removed.
